# Focus Text: Inside the Villains Focus Genre:Fairy Tales

After studying the book and exploring the structure and features of the text, the focus of our writing will be on recreating a Fairy Story villain, embellishing our writing with paper engineering (pop-ups, flaps, mechanical devices etc).

Focus Text: Harry Potter - A Journey Through a History of Magic

Focus Genre: Non-Fiction

The focus of this unit will be on creating a mini-book based upon the Chronicles of Narnia.

Focus Text: The Day the Crayons Quit Focus Genre: Fiction

The focus of this unit will be on writing a story through a series of letters

After exploring poetic techniques we will be telling a story through poetry, making choices about poetic devices.
